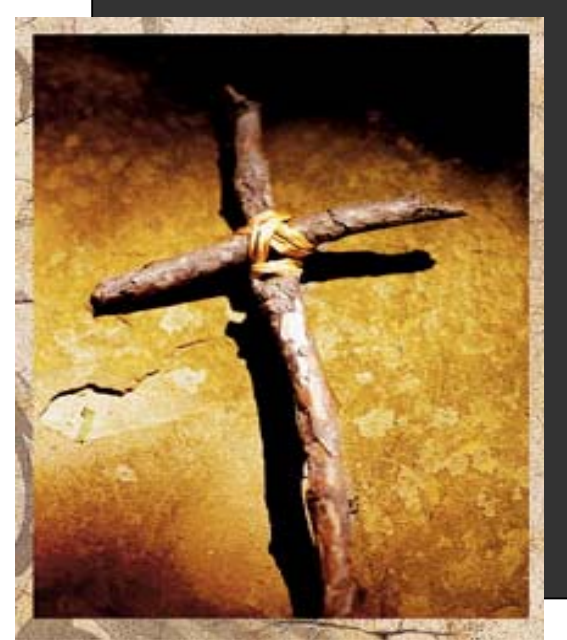


Who is Jesus?

Who is Jesus?

Jesus is the Son of God

“And the angel answered and said to her, ‘The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.’” Luke 1:35

Jesus Sits at the Right Hand of God

“Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.” Acts 5:31

Jesus is the Messiah

“The woman said to Him, ‘I know that Messiah is coming’ (who is called Christ). ‘When He comes, He will tell us all things.’” John 4:25

Jesus is the Great Teacher

“You call me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am.” John 13:13

Jesus is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords

“And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.” Revelation 19:16

Jesus is the Chief Cornerstone

“Have you not even read this Scripture: ‘The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone.’” Mark 12:10

Jesus is the True God

“And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.” 1 John 5:20

Jesus is the Door

“I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.” John 10:9

Jesus is the Good Shepherd

“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.” John 10:11

Jesus is the Bridegroom

“He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled.” John 3:29

Jesus is the True Vine

“I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.” John 15:1

Jesus is the Head of the Church

“For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.” Ephesians 5:23

Jesus is our Example

“For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.” 2 Corinthians 8:9

Jesus is a Man of Compassion

“And Jesus, when He came out, saw a great multitude and was moved with compassion for them, because they were like sheep not having a shepherd. So He began to teach them many things.” Mark 6:34

Jesus is our Mediator

“For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us...” Hebrews 9:24

Jesus is our Judge

“And He commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that it is He who was ordained by God to be Judge of the living and the dead.” Acts 10:42

Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath

“And He said to them, ‘The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath. Therefore the Son of Man is also Lord of the Sabbath.’” Mark 2:27-28

Why Did Jesus Come to Earth?

Jesus Came to Fulfill Old Testament Prophecy

“For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.” Isaiah 9:6

Jesus Came to Accomplish the Will of His Father

“I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me.” John 5:30

Jesus Came to Take on the Likeness of Humanity

“For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh...” Romans 8:3

Jesus Came to Model Servanthood

"Behold! My Servant whom I have chosen, My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased! I will put My Spirit upon Him, and He will declare justice to the Gentiles.” Matthew 12:18

Jesus Came to Preach a Message of Repentance

“From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, ‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.’” Matthew 4:17

Jesus Came to Call Sinners to Repentance

“Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, ‘The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.’” Mark 1:14-15

Jesus Came to Extend Forgiveness of Sin

“Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.” Acts 5:31

Jesus Came to Call Disciples

“And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.” Matthew 10:1

Jesus Came to be a Sacrifice for Sin

“He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.” Hebrews 9:26

Jesus Came to Carry the Cross

“And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha.” John 19:17

Jesus Came to Shed His Blood

“And He said to them, ‘This is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many.’” Mark 14:24

Jesus Came to Give His Life

“For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.” 1 Timothy 2:5-6

Jesus Came to Die

“That the saying of Jesus might be fulfilled which He spoke, signifying by what death He would die.” John 18:32

Jesus Came to be Buried

“...He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures...” 1 Corinthians 15:4

Jesus Came to Rise Again

“And He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.” Mark 8:31

Benefits of a Life With Christ

Jesus Removes Sin

“The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, ‘Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!’” John 1:29

Jesus Offers Salvation

“For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men...” Titus 2:11

Jesus Brings Deliverance

“...who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father.” Galatians 1:4

Jesus Brings Reconciliation

“...that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.” Ephesians 2:16

Jesus Brings Justification

“Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life.” Romans 5:18

Jesus Brings Sanctification

“Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.” Hebrews 13:12

Jesus Gives Joy

“These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full.” John 15:11

Jesus Gives Hope

“...having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.” Titus 3:7

Jesus Gives Rest

“Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.” Matthew 11:28

Jesus Gives Peace

“Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.” John 14:27

Jesus Reveals Truth

“For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.” John 1:17

Jesus Makes Intercession

“Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.” Romans 8:34

Jesus Brings Healing

“The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed.” Luke 4:18

Jesus Brings Freedom

“Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.” John 8:36
